Storage for small mechanical items is in medium sized boxes which interlock on top of each other and lifted three at a time by trolley. Clothes are packed in laundry type bags with handles. They can be moved individually or stacked two at a time on trolley. Clothes racks have wheels and can easily be rolled by one or two people.
